

Examining Changes to Virginia Graeme Baker Rules and Regulations



On Sails of Stone (classic)

Through his long career creating watershapes ranging from small fountains to large waterfalls and streams, landscape artist and sculptor Frederick L. Gregory always sought to harmonize the primordial splendors of nature with current times and settings.
