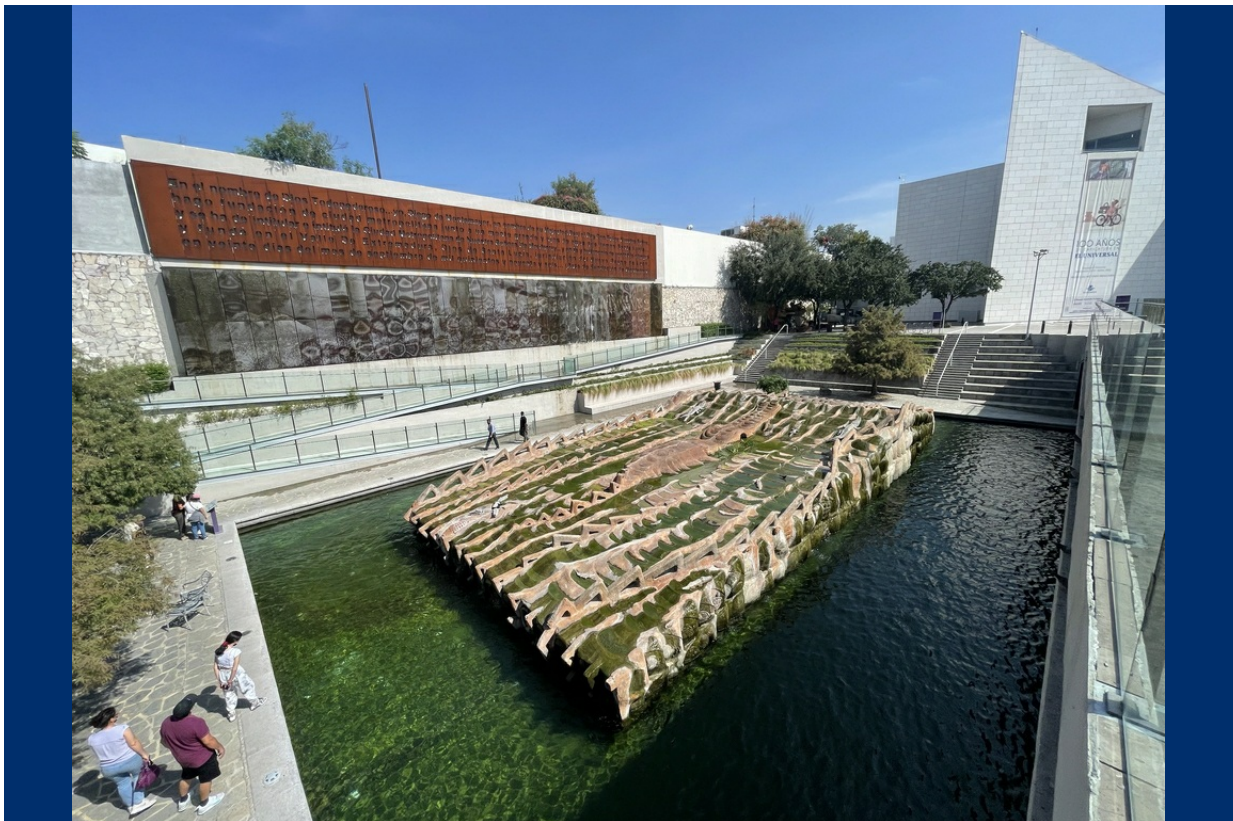

WU Steps Forward in Dallas

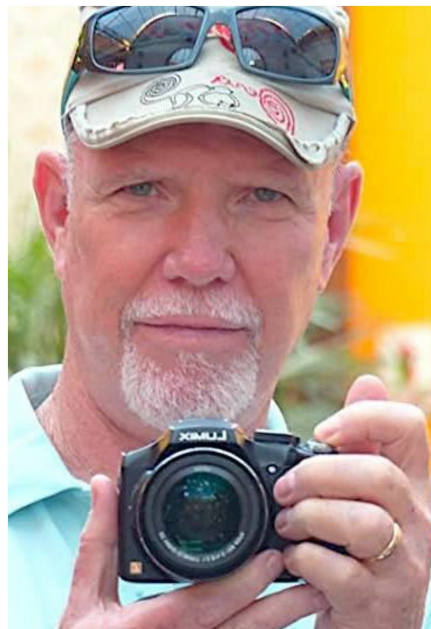
